Privacy

It is not an offence not to quote your tax file number (TFN). However, your claim will be delayed if you do not quote your TFN.

The ATO is authorised by the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1936* and the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1997* to ask for information on this claim. We need this information to help us to administer the taxation laws.

We may give this information to other government agencies authorised by law to receive it—for example, benefit payment agencies such as Centrelink, the Department of Education, Science and Training and the Department of Family and Community Services; law enforcement agencies such as the National Crime Authority; and other agencies such as the Child Support Agency, the Australian Bureau of Statistics and the Reserve Bank of Australia.

Read and sign the declaration after completing your baby bonus claim.

- I have determined that I am eligible to claim the baby bonus
- if transfer details are completed I have also completed the 2004 baby bonus transfer agreement on page 3 in the instructions and I understand that this cannot be changed or revoked

- I understand the ATO has the right to review my claim and, for a period of up to six years, to issue me with a revised assessment if a review shows any inaccuracies in income or entitlements that change my assessment.

If you are lodging a tax return, your baby bonus claim must be attached to the last page of your tax return. The lodgment address for the baby bonus claim is the same as for the tax return.
