### USM remittance run change

We have identified an issue with USM remittance runs. Since 17 December 2025, some of the payments in these remittance runs did not include credit interest components for accounts.

We're currently working to resolve this issue. To avoid new remittances being affected, we have cancelled USM remittance runs for this week (21 January 2026) and next week (28 January 2026).
