Use these tools to help you check your eligibility to claim fuel tax credits and the amount you can claim.

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Tools for claiming fuel tax credits

Use the:

- [eligibility tool](#) to check if you can claim fuel tax credits for your business activities
- [calculator](#) to work out the amount you can claim.

These include step-by-step instructions. If you need help when answering a question:

- select the **Help '?'** button at the top of the screen
- hover over the '?' at the end of a question.

Eligibility tool

The [fuel tax credit eligibility tool](#) helps you check if you can claim fuel tax credits for fuel you acquire and use in your business.

To see if you're eligible to claim fuel tax credits for domestic electricity generation and non-profit emergency vehicles and vessels, check your [eligibility](#).

Calculator

Fuel tax credit rates change regularly. The [fuel tax credit calculator](#) is the easiest way to help you work out:

- the fuel tax credit amount to report on your business activity statement (BAS)
- adjustments for fuel tax credits from a previous BAS.

From 1 April to 30 June 2026, fuel tax credit rates changed and the heavy vehicle road user charge was set to zero for 3 months.

From 30 March 2022 to 28 September 2022, fuel tax credit rates were temporarily reduced. For more information, see [Rates – business](#) or [Rates – non-business](#).
