Registered agent lodgment program available now

Access the lodgment program and find important tips to help your practice manage lodgments.

The **Registered agent lodgment program** 2025-26 is available on our website now.

You'll find due dates listed by month, tax return and obligation type and learn how overdue prior year returns, or a lodgment prosecution can affect your clients' due dates.

The due dates for your clients' tax returns will be available in ATO online services by the end of July.

Tips for managing lodgments

We provide the lodgment program to help you manage your workload; however, good planning and lodging progressively are still essential.

We also recommend you:

- engage your clients early to obtain the information you need to lodge
- know how to ensure clients are covered by your lodgment program
- review your client list to add new clients and remove those who no longer use your services
- regularly check your clients' lodgment due dates as they may change if your clients' circumstances change
- **notify us if lodgment is not required** or if further returns are not necessary.
