Small Business Super Clearing House scheduled maintenance

Your clients may need to adjust their payment arrangements to ensure their super payments arrive on time.

Published 17 June 2024

The Small Business Super Clearing House will be unavailable between 22 and 23 June 2024, due to scheduled maintenance. You can view the most <u>up-to-date timeframe here</u> 2.

For the quarter ending 30 June 2024, your clients' superannuation guarantee payments for their eligible employees are due by 28 July. However, as this date falls on a weekend, they have until the next business day.

If your clients plan to claim an income tax deduction for the 2023–24 financial year, super funds will need to receive the payments on or before 30 June 2024. They may need to adjust their plans to ensure payments arrive on time.

If the super funds receive the payments after this date, your clients may not be able to claim an income tax deduction for the 2023–24 financial year.
