Information for non-individuals about how to apply for a tax file number. (NAT 3799)

Companies and other organisations can apply for a tax file number (TFN) online at abr.gov.au .

If you:

- only need a tax file number (TFN), select
 - **Apply for an ABN** (Australian business number)
 - **Applying for other registrations** link
- need both a TFN and an ABN, select
 - **Apply for an ABN** link – to apply for both at the same time.

The online option is available for a:

- company
- partnership
- trust
- other organisation – such as an unincorporated company, club or association.

Other ways to apply

You can also apply for a TFN:

- through your registered tax agent
- by completing the form *Tax file number – application for companies, partnerships, trusts and other organisations* (NAT 3799)
