When to use this form

Under subsection 426-180(2) of schedule 1 to the *Taxation Administration Act 1953*, you can revoke an agreement to comply with the community charity corporation guidelines by sending us the revocation using this approved form.

You must complete this form if both of the following apply:

- you are a director of the company
- you want to revoke an agreement made under paragraph 426-180(1)(c) of schedule 1 to the *Taxation Administration Act 1953*.

Completing the form

- Download a copy of the form to your computer and check that you can save information in the form, or print it and complete a paper copy
- Type directly into the form
- Place X in all applicable boxes
- Be sure to answer all questions.

If you can't save a completed copy of this form, print a copy before closing the form.
