

Declaration for an exemption of GST on a car or car parts – person with a disability who is gainfully employed

Who should use this declaration?

If you are a person with a disability who is eligible to buy or lease a car, or buy car parts GST-free, you must present this declaration to your motor vehicle or car parts supplier.

0

You do not need to send this declaration to the Australian Taxation Office. This declaration needs to be kept by your supplier to support supplying the car or car parts to you GST-free.

You or your authorised person must sign and date the declaration before providing it to your supplier.

We recommend you keep a copy of this declaration and any supporting documents for your records.
