

Nomination of a legal representative to act on behalf of a non-individual entity

The fastest way to nominate a representative is over the phone – see **Find out more** below.

Use this form if you are the authorised contact for a non-individual entity and you want to nominate a legal representative. A legal representative could be a legal practitioner (barrister or solicitor) or a legal practice.

If you are an individual wishing to nominate a legal representative, use *Nomination of a legal representative to act on behalf of an individual* (NAT 11525).

It is important to know that:

- any nomination will continue indefinitely until you let us know that it no longer applies
- nominating a legal representative does not cancel any previous nomination
- you will need to phone us if you no longer want a representative to act on behalf of the entity – see Find out more below.

SCOPE OF LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE AUTHORITY TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE ENTITY

To nominate a legal representative to be the authorised representative for all matters administered by the ATO, you must indicate this by marking \mathbf{X} next to 'concerning all of the taxation affairs of the entity', under section B.

You can limit the legal representative's authority to specific matters only. Indicate this by marking \mathbf{X} next to 'concerning the following specific matter(s)', under section B.

Be clear about how much authority you give

Think carefully about the extent of the authority you are giving. The ATO will only discuss the entity's taxation affairs with the legal representative according to the statement of authority on this form. The names of the legal firm and specific authorised legal representatives will be placed on the entity's record as authorised representatives. No discussion of the entity's affairs can take place unless authority to do so has been recorded on our systems and the proof of record ownership process is satisfied.

If you phone, after identifying the entity's account, you must be already recorded on ATO systems as an authorised contact.

If you phone you will need to establish your identity by providing details of three of the following items that are currently on our records – for example:

- your date of birth
- your telephone number, business, residential, postal or email address (maximum of one)
- your bank account number (BSB number not required) and/or
- details from an ATO-generated notice (maximum of two different notices – for example, the sequence number from any notice of assessment issued to you).

To help with your enquiry, you may also quote the entity's tax file number (TFN).


