1 Name

3. Schedule 1, item 2	The later of: (a) the day after this instrument is registered; and (b) the day the <i>Jervis Bay Territory Emergency Management Ordinance 2015</i> commences. However, the provisions do not commence at all if the event mentioned in paragraph (b) does not occur.
