Goods and services tax: what are the registration requirements for resident agents acting for non-residents?

This Addendum is a public ruling for the purposes of the *Taxation Administration Act 1953.* It amends Goods and Services Tax Advice GSTA TPP 010 to update the Date of Effect section to reflect the amendments within the *Tax Laws Amendment (2010 GST Administration Measures No. 2) Act 2010* which came into effect on 1 July 2010.

GSTA TPP 010 is amended as follows:
