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## Addendum

### **Goods and Services Tax Advice**

Goods and services tax: does a credit card chargeback by a financial institution against a merchant give rise to an adjustment event for the merchant?

This Addendum is a public ruling for the purposes of the *Taxation Administration Act 1953.* It amends Goods and Services Tax Advice GSTA TPP 017 to update the Date of Effect section to reflect the amendments within the *Tax Laws Amendment (2010 GST Administration Measures No. 2) Act 2010* which came into effect on 1 July 2010.

#### GSTA TPP 017 is amended as follows:

#### 1. Application of this GST Advice

#### Application of this GST Advice

This Advice applies [to tax periods commencing] both before and after its date of issue. However, this Advice will not apply to taxpayers to the extent that it conflicts with the terms of a settlement of a dispute agreed to before the date of issue of this Advice (see paragraphs 75 and 76 of Taxation Ruling TR 2006/10).
