Goods and services tax: what is an invoice for the purposes of the A New Tax System (Goods and Services Tax) Act 1999 ('GST Act')?

This Addendum amends Goods and Services Tax Ruling GSTR 2000/34 to reflect the amendments to the A New Tax System (Goods and Services Tax) Regulations 1999 resulting from the commencement of the A New Tax System (Goods and Services Tax) Amendment Regulations 2007 (No. 1). This Legislative Instrument changes the threshold amount for the requirement to issue a tax invoice from 1 July 2007.

GSTR 2000/34 is amended as follows:

1. Paragraph 10

Omit '\$50'; substitute '\$75'.

2. Paragraph 56

Omit '\$50'; substitute '\$75'.

This Addendum explains our view of the law as it applied from 1 July 2007. You can rely upon this Addendum on and from its date of issue for the purpose of section 105-60 of Schedule 1 to the Taxation Administration Act 1953. If this Addendum conflicts with a previous private ruling that you have obtained or a previous public ruling, this Addendum prevails.
