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### **Superannuation Contributions Determination**

Superannuation Contributions Determination SCD 2000/4 is withdrawn with effect from today.

1. SCD 2000/4 documents the surchargeable contributions threshold and the indexable amounts for the 2000-2001 financial year under the *Superannuation Contributions Tax Imposition Act 1997* (SCTI Act) and explains how they are calculated.
