Taxation Determination TD 2005/7 is withdrawn with effect from today.

- 1. TD 2005/7 deals with interim measures relating to changes announced in 2003 in respect of the treatment of capital protected borrowings. Specifically, it explains when interest payable on a capital protected loan facility with a call option writing feature is deductible under section 8-1 of the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1997* (ITAA 1997).
- 2. Capital protected borrowings are now dealt with by Division 247 of the ITAA 1997.
- 3. TD 2005/7 has no ongoing relevance, and is therefore withdrawn without replacement.
