Instructions for tax agents

This publication contains a list of codes to assist you to correctly complete the *Individual tax return 2002* on behalf of your clients. You must provide an accurate description of a taxpayer's main salary and wage occupation at item 1 of the tax return, and insert the appropriate 4-digit code from the list at label X of this item.

If the taxpayer was involved in more than one salary and wage income-earning activity, provide the description and code for the activity that produced the greatest amount of income. Please note that the occupation description and code apply to salary and wage income only and not to other types of income such as pensions and business or investment income.

The codes are based on the *Australian standard classification of occupations* (ASCO) as provided by the Australian Bureau of Statistics. As ASCO uses gender specific terms to describe some occupations, such as postmaster/mistress, the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) is also obliged to use such descriptions in this listing.

The codes in this publication are in alphabetic order and numeric order. In the first instance use the alphabetic list to select the appropriate code to enter on the tax return by searching under keywords that describe the taxpayer's main salary and wage income-earning occupation.

For example:

- ambulance officer—search under the keyword 'ambulance' to find the code 3909
- shipping clerk—search under the keyword 'shipping' to find the code 5503
- security guard—search under either of the keywords 'security' and 'guard' to find the code 8911.

Once you have identified the most appropriate code from the list, enter it at label X, item 1 of the tax return.

If you cannot select the code using the alphabetic list, your second option is to use the numeric list. Here you need to search for the main occupation of the taxpayer under relevant broad occupation category headings.

For example, if a taxpayer earned the most salary and wage income from working as a personnel manager, you would search under headings related to 'managers'. In this case, the closest heading would be SPECIALIST MANAGERS. In the SPECIALIST MANAGERS group the appropriate entry, Personnel and industrial relations manager—code 1309, can be found. Enter this code at label X, item 1 of the tax return.

The numeric list may contain more than one major category for some occupations. For example, clerical work is covered by several different headings, such as STENOGRAPHERS AND TYPISTS and DATA PROCESSING OPERATORS. In this case, you may have to examine each category to find the most appropriate code.

If you cannot find an appropriate specific occupation code in either list, enter an accurate description of the taxpayer's occupation and use the 'Occupation not listed' code 9900. Please use this code as a last resort only.

Only use codes from the publication *Salary and wages occupation codes 2002* and take care to describe and code occupations as accurately as possible. An incorrect code may result in your client not receiving necessary service or material from the ATO or could lead to incorrect targeting of an audit.
